Saint Mary's Hospital is an acute care, community teaching hospital located at 56 Franklin Street in Waterbury, CT. Licensed for 347 beds, the hospital offers a Level II Trauma Center, a flourishing residency training program, a host of specialty medical services and skilled, compassionate healthcare providers.



Situation

For this project, St. Mary's had to train over 200 physicians on their new Electronic Medical Records Documentation System "Paragon". The training consisted of over 20 different modules. Gathering all physicians into a classroom environment for days of training was impractical. For years St. Mary's had used traditional methods, such as classroom-style, in-person learning, to train physicians, nurses, administration and support teams. As new training continued to grow at a rapid pace, senior management came to realize that these methods were no longer the best solution.

Traditional, in-person training methods were costing the company 20X more per hour. Further, these "information dumps" were not particularly effective methods of knowledge transfer. The Hospital had to rely on employees to proactively seek out information, and results were not predictable or easily measured.



Issues With Implementation

- » Physicians not responsive to classroom training.
- » Attitude—EMR implementation was a "Hospital Problem" not theirs. Just want to see patients.
- » Hospital risked pushing too hard and losing physicians to other hospitals nearby.
- » Issue of training before "Go-Live" but not using EMR until weeks down the road.
- » Older physicians with less technical knowledge and doing things one way for years were pushing back.
